

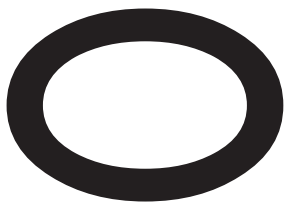

Spindle Cards

Adapting the Spindles Boxes to Spindles Cards is my original design.

For best results print on yellow colored 67 pound vellum **coverstock** (not cardstock - coverstock is not as stiff as cardstock). When cutting do not cut off the small flaps on the left side of each page. After cutting, fold each piece accordian style (up, then down, then up, etc.)

After folding individual sections then use gluestick to glue the small flaps under each section matching the corresponding fold. Each of the numerals should be on the left side of the fold.

Use small craft sticks for spindles - you will need 45 sticks. Or you can cut wooden skewers to about five inches long with a wire cutting pliers and then sand edges smooth. This material is tackle box friendly, and you can use this material in my Intro to Math tackle box.
