

STATE PIN FLAGS

This set is designed to fit in a tackle box.

Pin flags are use on a map placed on a bulletin board by continent.
Student is to pin the appropriate flag to the appropriate country.



To mount these flags I used long Dritz brand quilting pins - about 1-1/12 in long.

Print on 1 x 2-5/8 (30 per page) address label stock.

Lamination is not necessary but if desired cover entire sheet of flags with contact paper before cutting, or put laminate **only on top** of labels and run through laminator. If laminated each label will have to be cut out by hand before reoving sticker backing.

Stick the far ends of the label together first - sliding sticky label together between your fingers - lining up edges carefully and leaving jus enough space to slip the pin in the center of the label to make a two- sided flag.
